TEES

Men: Silver Tees | **Ladies:** Red Tees | **Seniors*:** Blue Tees

*Seniors must be 60 or older. If you choose to play up a tee, your handicap will be adjusted in accordance with Section 3.5 of the USGA Handicap System. You must notify Melissa Holmberg ASAP if you wish to play the senior tees so that your handicap can be adjusted.

“PLAY TO WIN” FLIGHT FORMAT (TWO PERSON BEST BALL)

Exchange scorecards before play with your playing competitors. On the scorecard, both players will record their Gross Score on the line next to their name for each hole. The lowest Net Score of the two balls will be marked on the yellow line provided on the bottom of the scorecard. The individual Net Score is determined by subtracting the number of black dots from that individual's Gross Score. The team's Total Net Score will be calculated by adding the net scores on the yellow line at the completion of the round.

“ALL ABOUT FUN”, NON-COMPETITIVE FLIGHT FORMAT: (TWO PERSON SCRAMBLE)

After each shot, the better of the two shots is selected and both players play from that spot, until the ball is holed out. One team gross score is recorded. **MAXIMUM SCORE:** Golfers should pick up and quit keeping score once they reach “double par.” *Example:* 6 on a par 3, 8 on a par 4 and 10 on a par 5

TIES

All ties will be decided by a scorecard playoff: (1st Tiebreaker–Summit back nine, 2nd Tiebreaker–Summit front nine, 3rd Tiebreaker–Valley back nine, 4th Tiebreaker–Valley front nine).

THE NATIVE

The Native area will be played as a Red Penalty Area if you are unable to find your golf ball. If you find your ball, you need to play it. Drop your ball within 2 club lengths from the point the ball crossed the Native. One Stroke Penalty.
