



2021 Mountain Golf Experience at Red Sky Golf Club

TEES

Men: Blue | **Ladies:** Red | **Seniors*:** Gold

*Seniors must be 60 or older. If you choose to play up a tee, your handicap will be adjusted accordingly. You must notify Mike Carver (See contact information below) prior to 9/15/21 if you wish to play the senior tees so that your handicap can be adjusted.

THE NATIVE

The Native area will be played as a Red Penalty Area if you are unable to find your golf ball. If you find your ball, you need to play it. For relief from the penalty area, you have three options: 1) You may take relief by dropping into a relief area using the spot at which your last shot was made under stroke and distance, 2) The back-on-the-line relief procedure or 3) Drop your ball within 2 club lengths from the point the ball entered the Native. One Stroke Penalty.

COMPETITIVE FLIGHT FORMAT (TWO PERSON BEST BALL)

Exchange scorecards before play with your playing competitors. On the scorecard, both players will record their Gross Score on the line next to their name for each hole. The lowest Net Score of the two balls will be marked on the yellow line provided on the bottom of the scorecard. The individual Net Score is determined by subtracting the number of black dots from that individual's Gross Score. The team's Total Net Score will be calculated by adding the net scores on the yellow line at the completion of the round.

"ALL ABOUT FUN", NON-COMPETITIVE FLIGHT FORMAT: (TWO PERSON SCRAMBLE)

After each shot, the better of the two shots is selected and both players play from that spot, until the ball is holed out. One team gross score is recorded. **MAXIMUM SCORE:** Golfers should pick up and quit keeping score once they reach "double par." Example: 6 on a par 3, 8 on a par 4 and 10 on a par 5

TIES

USGA recommended last 9, last 6, last 3, last 1.
